Follow up briefing regarding USM counts, costs and system impact.

MCSO contracts with the US Marshals Office to house pretrial inmates attending court matters at the US Courthouse. The county forecasts revenue based on the contract and projected number of bed days used at the contract rate as part of the budget adoption process. Analysis is needed to determine an accurate forecast, as well as determining actual costs and impact to the general fund.

FY2011 US Marshal contract was budgeted at just under 6.5 million dollars.

MCSO maintains legal authority to detain federal prisoners by both statute and through the meeting


of federal requirements with regard to inmate custody and care.
