## General Information

### 1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

Approval of an IGA with the Oregon Department of Transportation for improvements at the intersection of US 30 and Cornelius Pass Road.

### 2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

The Oregon Department of Transportation has been planning improvements to the intersection of Hwy US 30 at Cornelius Pass Rd for a few years. The Roadway Safety Audit performed by the County in 2008 (with Federal Highway Administration leadership) helped identify an opportunity to accelerate the execution of that project. Accordingly, ODOT has moved execution from 2016 to 2013.

As part of that improvement work, the County has asked ODOT to replace an aging culvert very near the intersection. By performing this work as part of a larger project, we are able to save cost, improve the drainage flow, and most importantly, minimize inconvenience to the users of Cornelius Pass Road.

This IGA documents the County's request for that work and details the participation on cost of the work.

This work is aligned with Program Offer 91013, Department of Community Services – Road Services.

**3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).**

There are minor costs associated with improvement to our infrastructure (at our request). These costs would be borne by the Road Services Program in the near future anyway, and this is a much more cost effective solution.

All project notification will be accomplished by the ODOT team. The intent is for multiple project notices to the general public and for local residents.
