## General Information

### 1. What action are you requesting from the Board?

The Assessor is requesting the Board approve the private sale of a tax foreclosed property to the adjacent property owners Nancy R. Widener.

### 2. Please provide sufficient background information for the Board and the public to understand this issue. Please note which Program Offer this action affects and how it impacts the results.

The subject property (as shown in Exhibit A) was foreclosed on for delinquent property taxes and came into county ownership on September 23, 1999. A letter was sent to the adjacent property owner informing them how the strip located in their side yard was received by Multnomah County through tax foreclosure and that the strip is available to purchase through private sale. The adjacent owner contacted the county to purchase the strip at private sale per ORS 275.225. The parcel is approximately 325 square feet, is not buildable, and is on the current tax roll with a real market value of \$300. The adjacent owner offered to purchase the strip for \$200 from the county and plans to consolidate the parcel into their main account.

This action affects our Program Offer 72038 by placing a tax foreclosed property back onto the tax roll.

### 3. Explain the fiscal impact (current year and ongoing).

The private sale will allow for recovery of the delinquent taxes, fees, and expenses. The sale will also reinstate the property onto the tax roll (see Exhibit B.)

**4. Explain any legal and/or policy issues involved.**

No legal issues are expected. The parcel will be deeded "As Is" without guarantee of clear title.

**5. Explain any citizen and/or other government participation that has or will take place.**


No citizen or government participation is anticipated.


